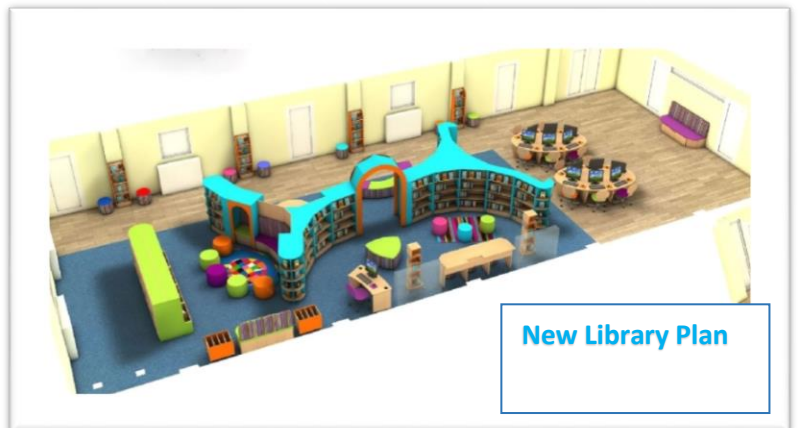
£9,250

Contributions to the school

All money raised by our fundraising activities is used to support the school both in developing the environment in which our children learn but also to enhance their experience at Raglan with a few fun extras too.

Funds have built up over the last few years so we have been able to make a significant donation of **£12,000** (with more committed for next year) to the library project which will go towards the revamp of the area and the books to fill it. This exciting new space will give the children a lovely place to choose and enjoy books as well as being an inspiring area to work.



Further donations have included:

£2,700 Fun activities such as a zoo day, Christmas parties, class gifts and a pantomime, Easter gifts and a contribution towards the Year 6 leaving party.

£2,500 Playground equipment, school sports flag and development of a Sensory Room.
