Dear Parents, Carers, Governors and Friends,

Thank you to everyone who attended the On Line Safety Training last night. Although the attendance was very disappointing (only 18 parents), feedback was extremely positive, with parents commenting on how much they had learned and that they had enjoyed the style of the presentation. There was also a work shop for Years 5 and 6 about the benefits of technology and how to keep themselves safe – the children all said that they had learned a lot and that they would think a bit more about their on line behaviour. This was followed by a workshop for staff which made us think and reflect, not only about how to support children to develop positive on line behaviour, but also to think about our own. Next Tuesday is Safer Internet Day, and although we know it is important to stay safe every day this will be the focus of our whole school assembly.
