Next week is an important week for our Yr 1 pupils. They will be taking their phonic screening assessment and have been focussing very hard on their phonic sounds.

Yr 6 writing is no longer assessed by a test, instead several pieces of writing are teacher assessed against a very stringent criteria. In order to verify teacher judgements and to ensure that this is a fair process across all schools, 25% of schools are externally moderated each year. Next week moderators will be spending a day at Raglan with our Yr 6 teachers looking at the children's writing as part of this process. I am very confident that there will be agreement with our judgements as the teachers have already carried out several moderation sessions with other schools within the borough.

Other news this week – our energy rating has improved from an E to a C, which is a real improvement and down to the vigilance of all the children and staff – turning lights off as they leave the room and making other small adjustments – such small acts have made such a big difference!

Our final Parent Forum of this year will take place on Wednesday 28th June – the focus, as requested at the last forum meeting will be spelling. All parents are invited to this and I do hope many of you will be able to attend.
