Rewards - Celebration of 'Good Behaviour'

Regular praise and encouragement is part of the school ethos.

Good behaviour is celebrated as follows:

- The half-termly Achievements Assembly.
- The Progress Cup awarded weekly.
- The Citizenship Cup awarded weekly.
- Headteacher's Certificates.
- 'Money' to buy gifts from school shop.
- Lunchtime Praise and Money cards.
- Praise.
- Stickers.
- Stars.
- Class Dojo – Class points on website.
- Sparkling Fire – Take home a sticker.
- Star of the week.
- Showing work around the school.
- Telling parents.
- Attendance certificate – Termly.
- Name in Newsletter – Half Termly.

Sanctions for 'Poor Behaviour'

- **Level 1** – Class Teacher warning to child.
- **Level 2** – Time out for reflection in another area of class for child.
- **Level 3** – Time out and reflection sheet in corresponding year group link class for child – 10 minutes but can be up to 20 minutes.
- **Level 4** – A child (**not the perpetrator**) sent to a member of SLT – with a message. SLT member will collect the child from the class.

'Below is a list of unacceptable behaviours'

The following behaviour is totally unacceptable and will **bypass** the level system and result in immediate referral to SLT:

- **Fighting.**
- **Racism.**
- **Swearing.**
- **Refusing to follow instructions from adults.**
 - **Damaging or Stealing Property.**
 - **Assault.**
 - **Bullying.**
 - **Putting Others at Risk.**
- **All incidents of unacceptable behaviour are recorded in class, playground, anti-bullying, racist incident and behaviour logs and letters.**

Class Reward Sheet - 'Raglan Money'

Name	House	Amount of money earned:

- **Each child will be given a purse or wallet they will be responsible for.**
- **Each time a child models or achieves something positive the child will be awarded 1p for their efforts.**
- **The child will then use a penny stamp to record their progress against their name in class.**
- **When a child achieves 10p they will be given a 10p coin (plastic) to either save (in their purse or wallet) or to spend as they wish in the school shop.**
- **If children choose to spend their money they must put a tick through the amount that they have spent on the class reward sheet.**

Level 4 Sanctions

Behaviour Letters and Reports

1st Incident:

- Letter home.

2nd Incident: Child put on report

- KS1 – 1 Week – DHT to oversee.
- KS2 – 2 Weeks – DHT to oversee.

3rd Incident:

- Letter home and parents come in to meet HT and possibly Inclusion Manager to discuss support and further ways forward.
- Letters are re-set every half term.
