
HANDA'S SURPRISE ALLEN BROWNE

Our Topic this term

This half term the children in Lower Language Class will be "Going on safari!"

We will be exploring Africa, locating it on a map, comparing an African village to our local area and learning about the different animals. We will be using batik and animal prints in art to create our own paper and African drums to create our own music. In our role play area we have built an African hut. Inside there are everyday items that might be found in an African village.

In Literacy we will be reading Lila and the Secret of Rain and Handa's Surprise. Both books are set in Africa. There will be lots of opportunity for writing character and setting descriptions, writing from different characters viewpoints and using drama to retell stories.



As mathematicians we will...

The children will be learning about different ways of measuring including length, weight and capacity. We will continue with number recognition and counting as well as addition and subtraction.

Our phonics sessions will be focussing on the Phase 3 letters and sounds including digraphs. Please continue your hard work, playing interactive phonics games and practising the sounds they have learnt.
