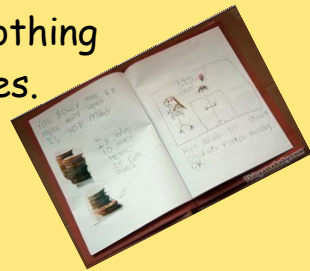
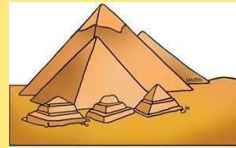


Year 4 Home Learning Jigsaw

Write a letter from Howard Carter to his family telling them what he had found

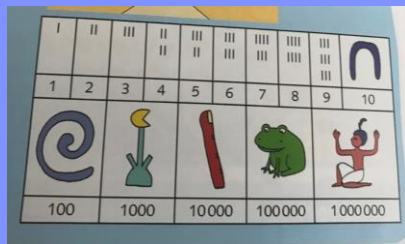


Re-write a traditional fairy story but set in Ancient Egypt (e.g. Red Riding Hood in desert visiting grandmother)

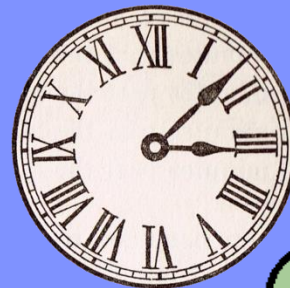


Make some Egyptian flat bread.

The Ancient Egyptians had a number system using seven different symbols. Choose ten different 2- digit numbers and write them using Ancient Egyptian number symbols. Now choose ten different 3- digit and 4- digit numbers.

Research the ancient Egyptian hieroglyphic alphabet. Write the symbols out then use them to write your name.



Write a diary entry about a day in the life as an Egyptian boy or girl.

Make a papyrus Scroll.



How many times on a 12- hour digital clock does the sum of the hours and minutes digits total 12? Predict, and then find out.
How many times on a 24- hour digital clock does the sum of the hours and minutes digits total 24? Predict and then find out.

Please note: Please encourage your children to record the information they find in their own words. This is far more beneficial as this is a key skill they will need in class.
