Dear our Fantastic Year 4 Parents and Children,

First of all, we would like to say a very big thank you for helping to support your child at home with their learning. We are very proud of all the children and the learning they have completed.

This half term, as we will be in school teaching full time, the learning that we assign will be slightly different and may not always be marked or looked at as often as it has been. This does not mean that we will not be looking at all the amazing and wonderful things that you have been doing at home. You will be receiving a project to complete all about Ancient Egypt, we will be assigning a weekly focus for you to concentrate on. This will be in addition to an Egyptian jigsaw of activities, which you can complete over the next 6 weeks. As before, we will also set a weekly comprehension task, which will be Egyptian based and expect you to read your allocated books on bug club, keeping up to date with mathletics and practicing your times tables.

If you would like to help support your child by revising what they have been taught in maths, here are some useful website and a list of what we have taught them this year:

What has been taught so far:

- Column addition - adding 4 digit and 4 digit numbers
- Column subtraction - subtracting 4 digit numbers
- Division - dividing 2 and 3 digit numbers by a 1 digit number with and without remainders
- Column multiplication - 3 digit numbers by 1 digit numbers
- Area and perimeter of rectilinear shapes
- Place value including: rounding to the nearest 10, 100 and 1000, comparing 4 digit numbers, negative numbers and counting in 25s and 1000s



- Fractions including: subtracting and adding fractions with the same denominator, finding equivalent fractions, looking at fractions greater than 1 and subtracting fractions from whole amounts
- Decimals: tenths, hundredths and equivalences to $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$ and $\frac{3}{4}$
