<p>Reading</p>  <p>Some of you still haven't logged on! Please do it this week!</p> 	<p>Read your reading books as usual – you should be aiming to read at least 5 times a week.</p> <p>Bug Club – Some of you are doing really well with your reading on Bug Club, well done. Remember to try and answer your questions carefully. Ask yourself if they will make sense to me when I read your answers.</p> <p>Frog Class Reading Challenge – You can keep this going for as long as you are off. See how many different types of texts (genres) you can read before we return. It will be great to share all the different ways you have managed to read during our time apart.</p> <p>Teach Your Monster to Read – Don't forget to log on to this at least 3 times a week, for 20 minutes each time. I shall be keeping a close eye on what you have been doing! All of you should be doing this, you all know how to.</p> <p>One person has read 14 Bug Club books so far, so they have earned 14 team points. WOW!!!</p> <p>Remember, you will continue to get a team point each time you read at home – I will keep a record of this. The person who reads the most while we are apart will win a prize!</p>
<p>Literacy – Peter Pan</p>	<p>Peter Pan – See Seesaw for all the details. You will be looking at the story, describing the characters, sequencing sentences, illustrating them and writing sentences.</p> <p>Word Wall learning – I gave you all a wordbook to keep at home. If you hear or read any words you don't know the meaning of, write them on the correct page in your wordbook. Then see if you can find out what they mean and write the definition next to it in your wordbook (always use a dictionary before Google, to keep your skills sharp!). Remember to check you have the correct spelling in your wordbook too.</p>
<p>Maths – Number work</p>	<p>Blue Squares and Green Circles will be learning about operations with number and Red Triangles will be doing addition and subtraction.</p> <p>Look at your group on Seesaw to see what I have planned for you this week.</p> <p>You will also need to do your Mathsletics learning too.</p>
<p>Foundation Subjects – Shadows</p>	<p>You are going to be learning about how shadows are made and what transparent, translucent and opaque mean. You will also be helping Peter Pan to find his shadow!</p>
<p>Additional Activities</p>	<p>Shadow art – create an amazing piece of artwork using shadows to help you!</p>
