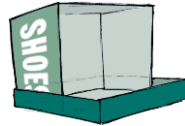


Year 5 Easter project

You could use a shoebox or an old cereal box to make your 3-D model, with the surface of Mars on the bottom, thinking about the texture and colour. Then think about what would you see out in space. Which planets might you see? Would you see the asteroid belt? Or the International Space Station or satellites passing by? Please no aliens!

We would like you to think about the resources you have at home which you could use: paper, cardboard, foil, modelling clay, mud(!), blu tak, paint, fabric, papier maché. Be imaginative!

When you have finished, upload the photos of your dioramas onto Seesaw so we can see your fabulous creations.
