

I hope you are all well and staying safe and alert during this time. As you know, our class along with Frogs, will be returning to school from Monday 15th June. Returning to School

From Monday 15th June, school will look a little bit different and to ensure that we keep you safe, we are making 3 "bubble" groups to ensure that you can keep a safe distance from each other (also known as social distancing). We have made the groups so that you will be with adults that you know, as well as children from Sharks class too.

Bubble 1 will be with myself on a Monday and Mrs Davies on a Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday.

Bubble 2 will be with Mrs Norris and Mrs Carberry.

Bubble 3 will be children from Frogs class with Miss Reid-Smith.

When you come back to school, you will be completing lots of fun learning and I know that Mrs Davies has been working really hard to come up with lots of fun activities for you to enjoy, both in the classroom and for outside too.

When you come in, you should **not** bring in your book bag. The only thing we would like you to bring is your own, named water bottle, a sun hat (for hot, sunny days – lots of your learning will be outside) and a piece of fruit for a snack in either a named Tupperware container or a zip lock bag (the fruit company that would usually deliver to school are not currently doing so at the moment). If the weather is hot, please ensure that you have put on sun cream before you come to school and one that is able to protect you for the duration of your time at school – we will **not** be allowed to reapply it for you.

Home Learning

If you are not coming back to school, then your home learning is going to look slightly different to what you have been used to. We will post on SeeSaw a range of activities that are fun, exciting and open-ended that you can access, in line with what the children who are in school will be doing. Whilst there will be lots of ideas, it will be up to you and your parents to decide which activities that you do. Of course, we will still want to see what you have been getting up to whilst you're at home completing your
