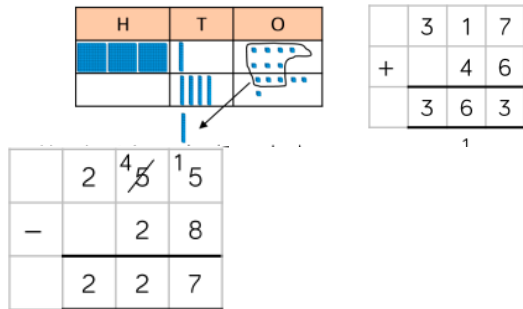
Written below are a list of Maths concepts that we have taught so far this year. To continue to support the learning at home, we would like you to continue to revisit and recap these concepts to secure the learning you have already completed and to prepare you for Year 4. We have also included a list of useful websites that you may wish to explore at home.

What has been taught so far:

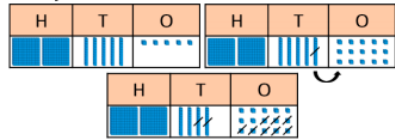
- ★ Place value- ordering/ comparing numbers to 1000, counting forwards and backwards in 50s/100s.
- ★ Addition and subtraction- 3-digit and 1-digit/3-digit and 2-digit/ 3-digit and 3-digit (crossing and not crossing).



Annie uses Base 10 to calculate $317 + 46$



Teddy uses Base 10 to subtract 28 from 255



- ★ Multiplying and dividing by 3,4,8- important for next year!
- ★ Multiplying and dividing a 2-digit by a 1-digit.

- ★ Money- converting pounds and pence, adding and subtracting money and giving change.
- ★ Length and perimeter.
- ★ Fractions- Finding fractions of amounts and shapes, tenths and tenths as decimals.
- ★ Time- Telling and recording the time to the quarter hour, 5 minutes and nearest minute.
